ABOUT THE PROGRAM

WHO IS THE PROGRAM FOR?

Students in grades 7, 8, and 9 are eligible to participate in the program.

Limit of 24 students.

WHEN DOES THE PROGRAM RUN?

The hockey program will be offered in Semester 1 of the 2026-27 school year, finishing at the end of January.

One hour sessions will be held twice a week on Tuesdays and Thursdays at the Access Communication Centre. Students will miss the end of their lunch and 4th period on these days.

WHAT DO STUDENTS LEARN?

The program brings a holistic approach to hockey by offering students the ability to develop their hockey skills, fitness levels, mental training and leadership. On-ice development focuses on skating, stick handling, passing, shooting, and more.
